- 1. The applicant should be (or should become) a member of IAP.
- 2. The age of the applicant should be below 40 years on 1 Jan 2020.
- 3. The applicant should be the lead researcher in the submitted research.
- 4. The research work should not have been published (may be submitted for publication) or should not have been presented earlier.
- 5. A detailed write-up of the research under the headings introduction, objective, methods, result, discussion and references. An abstract (max 250 words) is also to be submitted.
- 6. In case the research has more than one author, no objection certificate from the other authors should accompany the submission.
- 7. The applicant should submit his/her brief CV along with photograph. A statement of current and proposed research assignments is also to be submitted (max 250 words).
- 8. The list of other published papers of the applicant may be submitted.
- 9. A committee of experts will choose the awardee and its decision will be final.
- 10. The final selection is dependent on the primary research manuscript, presentation quality, and the statement of research work.
